

TUITION PAYMENT POLICY

Spencerian College, an independent, private, co-educational college of technology and healthcare, does not receive financial support of any kind from sources other than tuition, fees, and auxiliary enterprises. Due to the highly specialized training offered, the limited enrollment and small classes, the College quotes tuition charges on a **program** basis. Current program rates are listed below.

The College offers programs of study in day and evening, which range in length from 6 to 33 months, and enrolls students for **complete programs**. Applications for minor age students must be signed by a parent or guardian. Financial arrangements and payment terms must be completed on or before the scheduled date for entrance. After entrance, no examinations may be taken and no grades may be entered until all tuition and other fees are in order.

OFFICIAL TUITION REDUCTION ADJUSTMENT POLICY

If a student withdraws or is withdrawn from Spencerian College prior to the completion of the program, he/she will be obligated to Spencerian College based on the tuition reduction policy listed in the College catalog.

If a student withdraws or is withdrawn and has not paid the nonrefundable percentage of tuition, the remaining unpaid balance of the percentage must still be paid as agreed.

The College expects the student to complete his/her course of study. The program student has 1 1/2 times the normal length of the program to complete their course of study.
